The following Hockey Nova Scotia regulations apply to players released from teams participating in the Nova Scotia Major Bantam Hockey League.

Reg 20.2(d) **Residency** – Players must try out for the team within the Region in which the player resides. Should a player not be selected to the team within his Region, he shall have the option of trying out for all other teams, limited to one additional team at a time.

28.5 All releases shall be unconditional (subject to Regulation 28.3). A player receiving a release shall have the right to remain with the new team if he/she wishes. If he/she wishes to return to his/her original team at the end of the playing season to try-out for the team for the next season, they have that right. No player receiving a release can be forced to return to his/her original team. A player that transfers to another team after being released must notify the league registrar of their intent to return to their home association/regional team by April 12, otherwise they will remain with their current team.
